ARIZONA'S WATER SUPPLIES

Arizona has developed a diverse portfolio of water supplies and management strategies which serve as the foundation of our State's robust water system. This diversity allows Arizona to more effectively manage water resources and allows the state to subsist with the effects of existing drought conditions and also provides more options in planning for our states future economic growth.



HOW MUCH WATER DO WE USE AND HOW DO WE USE IT? ARIZONA'S WATER BUDGET

Arizona's water use can be divided into three categories: municipal, industrial and agricultural use. In 2014, Arizona's total statewide water use was approximately 7 million acre-feet.


Note: One acre-foot is equal to 325,851 gallons or the amount of water used by two families of four in a year.

100 YEAR WATER SUPPLY REQUIREMENT:


Within most urban areas of the state a 100-year water supply must be proven before land can be developed.
